The scientific journal Publicationes Mathematicae Debrecen, published and edited by the Institute of Mathematics (University of Debrecen) and its staff, celebrates its 100th volume this year. A hundred volumes represent nearly 4000 published research papers, the best of the work of thousands of authors. Browsing the volumes, we can also find historical documents such as the paper of Pál Erdős and Lajos Pósa On the maximum number of disjoint circuits of a graph (Publ. Math. Debrecen 9 (1962), pp. 3-12). PMD was founded by Alfréd Rényi, Tibor Szele and Ottó Varga in 1949/50. In addition to the founding editors, Andor Kertész, Béla Barna and Lajos Tamássy (editors-in-chief), József Szilasi (managing editor) and László Kozma (technical editor and consultant) played decisive roles in the history of the journal. The current editorin-chief is Professor György Gát. PMD is an internationally indexed English-language mathematical journal of Scimago Journal Rank Q2. It can be found in the database of Mathematical Reviews, Zentralblatt für Mathematik, Scopus, Web of Science, Index Copernicus and Science Citation Index. The journal appearing quarterly in two volumes a year (four issues per volume) provides an international forum for mathematical sciences by publishing annually about sixty articles in the field of theoretical mathematics. The network of partners due to exchanges and orders extends well beyond the European continent. It also reaches the United States, the Far East, and Australia.
